PRELIMINARY CONSULTATION/ NEEDS ASSESSMENT

Judith Lessing Landau, MD, DPM, LMFT, CFLE, CIP, CAI, CRS, President and CEO of Linking Human Systems, LLC, and ARISE® Network, and President of LINC Foundation, Inc., is a child, family and community neuropsychiatrist.
